

# Disability Officer Position Description

## Overview

As the Disability Officer at QUT Guild, you will be a dedicated advocate for accessibility, inclusivity, and the well-being of students with disabilities within the Queensland University of Technology community. This integral position involves coordinating initiatives, providing support, and fostering an environment that ensures equitable access to educational and extracurricular opportunities for all students.

## Key Responsibilities

- Participating in relevant QUT committees and working parties.
- Circulating information from the Guild to students who live with a disability, chronic health condition, mental health condition or injury as required.
- Representing and advocating for the views and interests of students who live with a disability, chronic health condition, mental health condition or injury to the SRC, University and on campus among the student body.
- Monitoring issues relevant to students who live with a disability, chronic health condition, mental health condition or injury both within the guild and university.
- Advising the executive committee, University and SRC of developments and needs in this area.
- Providing a high level of support to the Disability Collective.
- Carrying out such other duties from time to time that may be prescribed by the SRC or Executive Committee

## Hours

7 hours per week (80% on campus, 20% off-campus)

Hours may increase at peak times throughout the semester during Welcome Week, Guild Week and other events with the university.
