

# First Nations Officer Position Description

## Overview

As the First Nations Officer at QUT Guild, you will be a passionate advocate for Indigenous students, fostering cultural awareness, engagement, and support within the Queensland University of Technology community. This pivotal role involves coordinating initiatives, providing guidance, and working collaboratively to create an inclusive environment that respects and celebrates the diversity of First Nations cultures.

## Key Responsibilities

- Representing the rights and interests of First Nations students to the SRC and Executive, ensuring that First Nations voices and perspectives are highlighted in the work of the Guild.
- Assisting in the planning of initiatives, campaigns and events that benefit and represent First Nations students.
- Collaborating with the Oodgeroo Unit at QUT regarding any strategies and policies that QUT is planning on implementing that will affect First Nations students.
- Carrying out such other duties from time to time that may be prescribed by the SRC or Executive Committee

## Hours

7 hours per week (80% on campus, 20% off-campus)

Hours may increase at peak times throughout the semester during Welcome Week, Guild Week and other events with the university.
