

# Queer Officer

## Position Description

### Overview

As the Queer Officer for the QUT Guild, you will be a vital advocate for the LGBTQIA+ community, playing a key role in fostering inclusivity, awareness, and support within the student body. This position involves creating a safe and affirming space for queer-identifying students while promoting education and understanding throughout Queensland University of Technology.

### Key Responsibilities

- Assisting with the formulation of all policies relevant to the portfolio
- Encouraging and promoting LGBTQIA+ services of the Guild across all campuses of the university
- High level supporting of Queer Collective
- Monitoring any Guild, QUT, or wider policies to ensure the rights and interests of LGBTQIA+ students are represented and protected.
- Assisting with planning, setting of goals, and strategies for Queer initiatives, campaigns and events
- Ensuring the Guild acts in the best interests of LGBTQIA+ students in all its dealings
- Advising the Executive Committee of any LGBTQIA+ issues at QUT that will need to be addressed
- Communicating with LGBTQIA+ students about their experiences at QUT and advocating on their behalf for change and progress at QUT
- Carrying out such other duties as from time to time may be prescribed by the SRC or the Executive Committee.

### Hours

7 hours per week (80% on campus, 20% off-campus)

Hours may increase at peak times throughout the semester during Welcome Week, Guild Week and other events with the university.
